

Acting Alone or Acting Collectively?


Proprietary software "sweet-heart deals" Permanent or temporary? Creates lock-in

- What is needed to support open code? 3 Main elements ...






1. Committed Individuals


- Willingness to reciprocate sharing Willingness to engage and involve others Outreach is an overhead




